- Alternatively, there is an option to submit your report via social media by tagging @thecountyfoundation through Facebook or Instagram, with your photo and report written as a post or filmed as a video (2 mins max).
- The County Foundation will also ask permission to share this information to inspire others in future.
- Submit a copy of all receipts for your project

- You must return any unused grant money to The County Foundation.

Follow-up reports are due within 1 year of receiving funds.
