

The Municipal Financial Relief Grant is administered by The County Foundation. Prince Edward County low-income residents can apply for ONE of the two relief grant streams. Applications will be accepted from **April 15 to July 15**. Applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application before end of August.

<p><b>Who is eligible?</b> Residents who pay for water/waste services OR property taxes on their primary residence in Prince Edward County through a municipal tax account who earns \$32,240/year or less (for single occupants), or \$64,480/year or less (for multiple occupants).</p> <p>Applicants need to include a copy of their most recent water or property tax bill and a Notice of Assessment from Revenue Canada for ALL household occupants.</p> <p><b>Maximum grant:</b> A credit of \$350 for water/wastewater services or \$750 for property taxes may be applied to your water/wastewater account for September 2025. Households who earn \$20,000/year or less would receive a \$500 credit for water bills or \$1,000 for property taxes.</p>	<p><b>Who is eligible?</b> Residents with no municipal tax account who pay property tax on their primary residence to a leasehold in Prince Edward County who earn \$32,240/year or less (for single occupants), or \$64,480/year or less (for multiple occupants).</p> <p>Applicants need to include a copy of your Notice of Assessment from Revenue Canada for ALL household occupants, and a letter or pay statement from the landowner (leasehold) verifying payment toward property taxes in 2025.</p> <p><b>Maximum grant:</b> A cheque of \$750 for property taxes may be provided in September 2025. Households who earn \$20,000/year or less would receive a \$1,000 grant for property taxes.</p>

**Q-If I meet the income eligibility am I automatically approved?**  
A- Eligible applications may receive the grant as long as there is adequate supply of funds. Should there be high demand for this grant that exceeds available funds, priority will be given to those most in need in terms of income.

**Q-Where else can I get help with this application?**  
A - Three local organizations can help with completing online applications or downloading and attaching forms:  
• Prince Edward Learning Centre, Prince Edward County Community Care for Seniors Association and PEC Library.  
These services require an appointment but are free to community members.
