Working with a Qualified Donee partner

As part of this catalogue, we include organizations that operate in partnership with a qualified donee. These fiscal partnerships allow an organization to access funding through a partner that is eligible to receive grants. In these formalized arrangements, the charitable partner assumes legal responsibility for the use of funds.

In some cases, individual **projects or programs** may collaborate with a qualified donee to facilitate donations or fundraising on their behalf. These relationships have not been included in the catalogue, as they are not ongoing fiscal partnerships. However, we are happy to connect with donors who are interested in supporting these initiatives to explore how best to do so and maximize impact.
